Robinson's longtime Pilot Safety Course instructor, Tim Tucker, received the prestigious Cumberbatch Trophy. The Cumberbatch Trophy (first awarded in 1936) is bestowed yearly by the Honorable Company of Air Pilots (a UK-based organization founded in 1929) and recognizes outstanding contributions to aviation safety.

The trophy was presented to Tucker on 21 October at the 600-year-old London Guildhall. Tucker was instrumental in developing Robinson's well-known Pilot Safety Course, which launched in 1982. In 1992, he took the course on the road and, to date, has conducted over 120 overseas safety courses in 35 countries.

FAA Approves Cyclic Guard

Robinson's safety-enhancing cyclic guard is FAA approved for all R44 and R66 helicopters. The guard is recommended for use when the occupant of the left front seat is not a rated pilot. The guard installs easily and acts as a handhold or barrier reducing the likelihood of passengers inadvertently bumping or grabbing the cyclic.
